Typically, in July and August the park is busier and it may be possible to work extra hours, but this depends on weather, crowd size and staffing. After Labor Day (September 2) park is open on WEEKENDS ONLY. After Labor Day, students will work on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays, but there may be some work during the weekdays setting up Haunt and doing cleaning and inventory. Students are encouraged to travel during their time off to nearby east coast cities on weekdays in September when travel is cheaper and attractions less crowded.

### **Housing Details**

Housing details:

Dorney Park partners with a local college. Students are housed in the college dormitory. Students will share rooms (2-3 employees per room). Associates can only live in the dorm from May 13-August 11 (we will arrange hotel housing for associates for early spring and fall through October at the same cost). Couples will need to either find own housing or must split up (girls in girls dorm/boys in boys dorm)

Housing in the dormitories costs up to \$65 per week. However, if a student works less than 20 hours in one week, housing will cost \$40.00.

Employees who wish to find their own housing can apply for a housing subsidy. Those living in dorms do not qualify for the housing subsidy.

Amenities in the dormitory: Air Conditioning, free WIFI in each room, communal kitchen and bathrooms in each dorm, use of some of the additional college facilities (snack bar, library, bookstore, can purchase swim pass for an indoor pool, gym pass.). College in a safe area, close to the bank, grocery store, some restaurants, local bus service.
